No longer a brew pub, Green Man was able to focus on production, distribution and growth. With the help of the original brewer, John Stuart, and his team, Green Man has evolved into a respected and well-known brewery, known for consistent, traditional ales with a constant eye on quality. Using English and Belgian yeasts and specialty grains gives the beers their unique appeal and distinctive style. These brewers are known for their Gold Ale, Pale Ale, IPA (India Pale Ale), ESB (Extra Special Bitter), Stout, Porter, and Cask Conditioned Ale.*
